



#### PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Program to encourage **new and innovative ideas and projects** that address an unmet need or problem in the bleeding disorders community

- Grant amount \$5,000 \$25,000 USD
- Project duration 6 to 24 months
- Open to all WFH NMOs



#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAM**



**Assist** WFH NMOs in developing and strengthening their skills



**Provide** tools to help NMOs create and implement new, successful and sustainable development projects



**Empower** NMOs to better advocate and support the improvement of bleeding disorders care in their countries





## **SPECIFIC**

What do I want to accomplish?





## **MEASURABLE**

Can you track the progress and measure the outcome?





## **ACHIEVABLE**

Are the objectives reasonable enough to be achieved within this project, resources & timeline?





## REALISTIC / RELEVANT

Can I realistically reach my objectives?

Are the project objectives relevant to the local needs?





## **TIME-BOUND**

When does this objective need to be achieved?





#### PROJECT EXPECTED RESULTS



Expected results should be directly linked to your problem statement and project objectives



### **EXPECTED RESULTS - EXAMPLES**

#### **BEFORE**


 Hemophilia is not a priority for the Government

#### **AFTER**

 Hemophilia included in the list of non-communicable diseases and funding allocated for purchase of treatment products in the national healthcare budget


#### PROJECT APPLICATION FORM - BUDGET

Budget items should be detailed and related to each project activity

Activity	Budget description (please specify how the funds will be allocated)	Cost in \$ US
Example:	Example:	Example:
1. Training for NMO chapter leaders	<ul> <li>60\$ for transportation costs for 5 people = 300\$</li> <li>Rental of meeting space = 800\$</li> <li>Accommodation and meals for 20 participants for two days = 900\$</li> </ul>	2,000\$




# PROJECT MONITORING & EVALUATION





#### **KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS (KPI)**



Key performance indicators (KPIs) are specific measurement tools that will help you determine if your objectives have been achieved through the implementation of the project



## KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS - EXAMPLES

#### **Project**: Capacity-building on laboratory diagnosis

 Number of institutions that diagnose rare inherited bleeding disorders

## **Project**: Awareness-raising on MSK care for patients with bleeding disorders

Number of patients seeking / receiving MSK care

## **<u>Project</u>**: Outreach to identify people with bleeding disorders

- Number of newly identified people with hemophilia
- Number of newly identified people with vWD
