There exists a deep global inequity



75% of people living with hemophilia remain undiagnosed*. This represents more than the populations of Atlanta or Milwaukee. Rates of diagnosis are even lower for other bleeding disorders.



The median age of diagnosis in Southeast Asia is 50 months. In America it is less than 1 month.**



Even when diagnosed, treatment remains out of reach for many -- 72% of the world's population accesses a mere 18% of the available factor VIII worldwide, leaving many to suffer needlessly.*

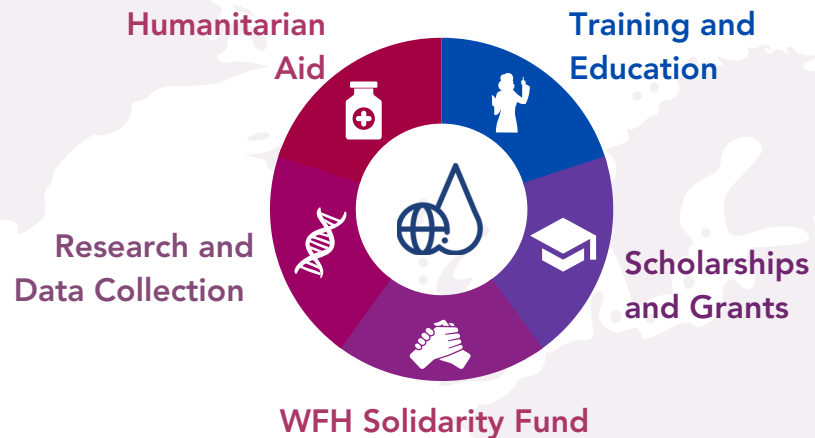
