



World Federation Hemophilia Gene Therapy Registry Governance

The WFH Gene Therapy Registry (GTR) has established a governance structure to ensure the continued success of the program (Figure 1).

Scientific Advisory Board

The role of the WFH GTR Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) is to provide expert scientific advice to the WFH regarding the WFH GTR, particularly focusing on the data charter, research policies, and scientific issues. Representatives on the SAB are nominated by their respective organizations. Each representative can represent only one organization. Membership will be for a duration of up to 4 years.

National Registries & Hemophilia Treatment Centres Consortium

The role of the National Registries & Hemophilia Treatment Centres Consortium is to provide a platform for collaboration, information and idea exchange on data usage, exchange, standardization, privacy, etc. The National Registries & Hemophilia Treatment Centres Consortium is a sub-committee of the SAB. Representatives on the Consortium are nominated by their respective organizations/country. Each representative can represent only one organization on the Consortium.

Steering Committee

The role of the WFH GTR Steering Committee (SC) is to provide leadership, oversight, and expert advice to the WFH regarding the GTR, particularly focusing on the development, implementation, and structure of the GTR. Representatives on the SC are nominated by their respective organizations. Each representative can represent only one organization. Membership will be for a duration of up to 4 years.

Industry Consortium

The role of the Industry Consortium is to provide insights into data needs, post-approval surveillance and long-term data needs.

GTR Patient Advisory Group

The role of the GTR Patient Advisory Group provides guidance on all patient related GTR initiatives.


Meetings are held on a regular basis, and on an ad hoc basis if necessary. All decisions are made by discussion and consensus. The WFH Board of Directors retains the right of approval or veto all decisions and helps resolve issues that cannot be resolved by the Scientific Advisory Board.
