PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVES



IHTC Fellowship Support

Support specialized training opportunities for health care professional from developing countries to strengthen diagnosis and care for people with bleeding disorders

Impact

1. Build local expertise and long term capacity
2. Expand access to specialized care
3. Create sustainable knowledge

Indicative Support Level : US \$5,000



Twinning Partnerships

Support specialized training opportunities for health care professionals from developing countries to strengthen health systems and improve care for people with bleeding disorders.

Impact

1. Strengthened healthcare systems
2. Improved quality of care
3. Increased local capacity

Indicative Support Level : US \$8,000



Women & Girls Initiative

Support awareness, education, and identification activities focused on women and girls with bleeding disorders.

Impact

1. Reduce stigma and misconceptions around bleeding disorders in women and girls
2. Improve recognition and earlier diagnosis
3. Support healthier maternal health outcomes and stronger family support

Indicative Support Level : US \$5,000 or \$15,000 to establish multidisciplinary care at a centre

**Support levels are indicative and may vary depending on country, region, and project scope.*



Awareness & Diagnosis Activities

Support community awareness and early identification initiatives to help people receive timely diagnosis and treatment.

Impact

1. Knowledge exchange
2. Identify undiagnosed patients
3. Improve access to care pathways

Indicative Support Level : US \$3,000



Access to Diagnostics & Reagents

Support access to laboratory supplies and diagnostic resources that are essential to identifying bleeding disorders.

Impact

- 1. Strengthen local laboratory capacity
- 2. Improve diagnostic accuracy
- 3. Expand patient access

Indicative Support Level : US \$5,000



Mobility & Orthopedic Support

Support specialized musculoskeletal surgical care for people with bleeding disorders to help them walk, move, and live independently.

Impact

- 1. Expanded access to care
- 2. Reduced disability burden
- 3. Improved patient outcomes

Indicative Support Level : US \$7,000
